SKILL LEVEL: ALL

Thursday Bonus Class

The Magic Triangle Method course is designed to teach anyone who would like to learn how to simplify rotary cutting and increase their accuracy of piecing. Upon completing the class, you will be able to convert any existing patchwork pattern to a magic triangle method pattern. Your course will include the amazing marking tool that eliminates the need to cut out any triangles with 1/8" measurements and three calculators. We will make a small sampler quilt that demonstrates all types of triangle units, including half-squares, quarter-squares, three-part squares, flying geese and square within a square. At the conclusion of the course you may elect to take the qualifying test to become a Certified Magic Triangle Method Instructor or may choose to remain a Magic Triangle Ambassador. A discussion of the Instructor benefits will be presented in class. This class is a great segue for the design class "Stargazing" with Peggy Bingham.

Stargazing - Magic Triangle Method

SKILL LEVEL: Intermediate

With the beloved Star motif as a block design basis, this class will explore block drafting and template-free rotary cutting techniques to make any block any size you want! You will learn Cindy Casciato's Magic Triangle method to create your own work of art!

We will work with lots of traditional star blocks *and* connecting blocks with simple shapes - squares, rectangles and triangles, plus some trapezoids. This is the class in which you become the designer! Your quilt top may be any size you desire! Peg will bring Electric Quilt® and a printer so everyone can audition their designs. The illustrations included on the website are only examples of what you may create!

Fabric guidelines, preliminary cutting instructions and fabric selection suggestions will be mailed to registered students. Magic Triangle Bundle and Stargazing Pattern fee: \$35.

With “Square-agonals®” you create a diagonal set quilt without cutting any setting or corner triangles, without any math calculations, or sewing in diagonal rows. Learning this technique gives you the basics and confidence to create other diagonal set designs the new easy way! (Class Fee \$5.00)

Studio Time / Studio Project “Making a Medallion”

SKILL LEVEL: All

Come and join me for a sit and sew class that allows you to set the pace. You can choose to work on my Studio Project “Making a Medallion” or finish some projects you already have underway. I am always available to help with any project you bring along.

You will learn how to make partial seam blocks that are split in half to create your medallion. Choose the Black and White fabric and add two bright contrasting prints or the more traditional floral print with soft taupe background and a contrast print. Both quilts require the use of solid black. All the pre-class cutting directions will be on-line so you can spend your time sewing in the studio. There is a pattern charge of \$8.00.

My Whimsical Garden

SKILL LEVEL: Intermediate

This is a really fun machine appliqué quilt featuring a raw edge finish embellished by decorative stitching. It can be a stash buster, using up those small pieces left over from other projects. The lightest possible weight of fusible web is used so that this quilt is soft and cuddly. This quilt is ideal for other embellishing, too, such as beads and enhanced quilting. Twenty ten inch blocks are supplied in the pattern, but you may choose to make a wall hanging or a twelve block full sized quilt as shown in the photo. During the weekend, other methods of machine appliqué will be demonstrated, so that when you get home, you can choose your favorite. Curvalicious

SKILL LEVEL: Intermediate

Curvalicious is a fun and amazingly easy project that features the Creative Grids Corner-to-Corner Curve ruler. Although there are *lots* of curved seams, Rita will show you how easy it is to get the effect of continuous ribbons of fabric as you make the 2 different blocks in this stunning quilt. A selection of 3 fabrics with high-contrast to each other works best with this project. The yardage amounts are determined by project size. Students can order pattern ahead of time, or contact Rita for yardage for the size they want to do.

Linda Huston

Color Weave

SKILL LEVEL: All

“Color Weave” is a variation on a very old traditional pattern (“rail fence”) that is usually done with scrap fabrics. This variation gives the illusion of the colors weaving over and under each other in a sort of basket-weave fashion. The black fabric aids in that illusion. This project is made by creating “strip sets” for each of the color combinations. Since the black strips are a part of the sets, each portion of the “weave” is very easily completed by accurately cutting each unit.

Accuracy is a must in this project. Students will learn the following: how to make strip sets; how to square up units; how to create a border that is made up of different colored sections (this involves measuring accurately so that these sections end up in the correct places on the border); and of course, the many little tips and tricks that I teach in all of my classes such as: using a “thread saver” while piecing; the easy string piecing method; and sew much more.

The use of black fabric in this variation gives an Amish styling to the quilt. The pattern was created by Debbi Russell, of Archbold, Ohio, and I have been given permission to teach this class in my shop and at Quiltescape.

Lynette LeGette

Stripe One

SKILL LEVEL: Intermediate

"You made that?!" is the amazed reaction you will get with this quilt. You must sew it to believe the results. No two alike. This pattern uses ONE fabric, ONE block design, ONE technique with NO strip sets! Select one bold striped fabric (stripes run parallel to selvages). **Fabric with stripes of various widths gives dramatic results.** WOW your friends and family and **surprise** yourself with this quilt. You may choose the wall size (29" X 42") or the lap size (47" X 60") to do in class. Contact me at: lslegette@att.net

Beverly Neff ***Old Fashioned Hospitality and Peas in a Pod***

SKILL LEVEL: Intermediate

You choose which project you want to do in class. I will be teaching both quilts from the same book.

Old Fashioned Hospitality – Choose this quilt and learn the art of 3-D wool appliqué using Kim Diehl's techniques to create an expression of your hospitality with this vivid quilt center with a stripy and colorful patchwork border. The homework I will ask you to do, with provided instructions, will be for you to have pre-sewed your block for the quilt center. This will enable us to spend our time together focusing on the aspects of the simple invisible machine appliqué techniques. You will learn just how easy it can be to prepare beautiful shaped appliqué and how your sewing machine can be used to invisibly stitch them in a fraction of the time needle-turn technique requires. This class is "sew do-able" for everyone. "Sew" go through your stash for the outside borders and center square and be prepared to share your Old Fashion Hospitality quilt with your family and friends when you return home.

Peas in a Pod (lap size) - Wow just snap some fresh peas straight from your stash with this winsome quilt in an abundance of warm colors. This is so good for you that you'll be sure to ask for seconds; that is, you'll want to make another quilt like it or enlarge this one. This quilt project truly helps reduce your stash! We have used over 60 different chubby sixteenth (9x11) or a total of 4 yards of assorted prints for blocks, borders, and yes even the scrappy binding. Having homework with this project will only consist of precutting strips into rectangles, and a few squares. By doing your homework this always assure you of having a more satisfying weekend retreat, taking home a completed project. The class project involves using Kim Diehl's appliqué techniques, which adds the finishing touch to make your blocks appear like a pieced circle. Like" two peas in a pod, this project is twice as easy and uses twice the fabric stash.

Both of my project choices come from the same book, "sew" if you can't make up your mind because you love them both, don't hesitate taking my class because I am offering instructions for both projects during the retreat.

Both projects are out of the same book. Book required - \$23.50 Kits available for both projects.

Quilting on your Home Sewing Machine

SKILL LEVEL: Beginner - Intermediate

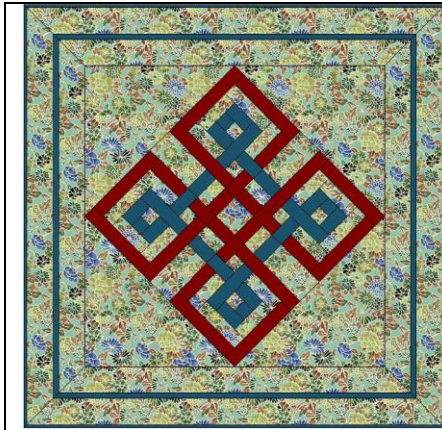
Sew, you have all these quilt tops piling up and are not sure how to quilt them? Or, are you tired of paying a longarm quilter to finish them for you? Then join Beth for the weekend and be ready to go home and finish all those quilt tops! We will start with an overview of straight line quilting using a walking foot. Then move into the "meat" of the class – feeling comfortable with freehand quilting. By dropping your feed dogs and using freehand techniques you truly CAN quilt large quilts on your home sewing machine! Don't be scared or shy away from freehand work. If you have just a little experience and are ready to move past plain old stippling, join us for a great weekend!

In a fun-filled, very relaxed and casual atmosphere, you will create samples of many different quilting stitches and designs. Beth calls this a "notebook" class. You will quilt your samples and organize them in a notebook which you can refer to for years to come as you start new quilting projects. And your friends and family will be so impressed and envious! You will receive handouts and make samples from Beth's popular "STIPPLING WITH STYLE" class series. Whether you favor traditional or art style, this will open up a whole new world of creative quilting for you.

During the weekend we will have discussions on layering your quilt, getting it into that small space on your home machine, what types of battings work best as well as which of today's beautiful threads will give you the best result. Students are encouraged to bring a finished quilt top for discussion in class on how to approach quilting it on your home sewing machine. You will go home with fresh ideas and enthusiasm and be ready to tackle that stack of quilt tops!
