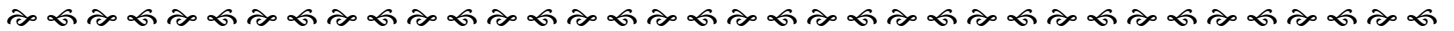

QUILTSCAPE -WEEKEND CHECK LIST

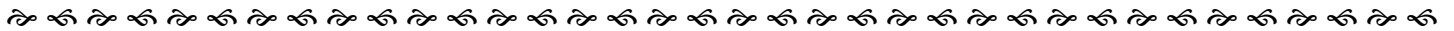
NOVEMBER 5, 6 and 7, 2009

1. **CLASS SUPPLIES AS DIRECTED BY TEACHER** - Machine if applicable.
2. **POWER STICK, EXTENSION CORD** - Strongly advised that you bring these.
3. **EXTRA LIGHTING** - Optional but a **VERY GOOD IDEA! A Clip-On Light is suggested.**
4. **CUSHION** - In case you need to adjust your seat height for sewing!
5. **MONEY - FOR THE VENDORS!!!**
6. A **FLASHLIGHT** might be good to tuck in since you never know what our plans may include.
7. **LAST YEAR'S FINISHED PROJECT FOR SHOW 'N TELL.** First Timers - bring something from home to share with us.
8. **REMEMBER** - Bring clothes (to layer) for outdoor activities - gloves, mittens, hat, scarf, warm jacket (for the hayride, etc.) Maybe even an old quilt to cover your knees!



FABRIC SWAP

This year's Fabric Swap is a 5" square of fabric. The color theme is Purple. Bring squares in shades of purple. You need to have 2 yards of your chosen fabric. From the 2 yards, cut 12 strips 5" wide the width of the fabric; then re-cut into 5" squares. This will give you 96 squares. **PLEASE USE ONLY ONE FABRIC FOR THE EXCHANGE.** This will help us enjoy the process of exchanging so we are not sifting through the piles of fabric and the line will move much quicker. We will exchange the fabric squares Saturday night after the banquet. We will have 4 stations for the exchange and utilize both sides of the tables to keep the lines short and moving along. We will have further instructions that night. **A free pattern will be provided for a lap size quilt.**

- **You must bring the quilt to Quiltescape 2010 for display and viewer's choice awards**
- You must make a quilt using the block, "My Mountain Home" that contains 52 pieces.
- The quilt must comprise of only this one block, a 1" wide border and binding.
- You must use the fat quarter fabric that you were given at your table and the color purple somewhere in the block. Purple will be the featured color next year.
- You may add as many additional fabrics and colors as you like.
- You may add any embellishment you would like to enhance your block.
- The block must be a completed little quilt for prize consideration and display.
- A new block challenge will be given out at the 2010 Quiltescape event.
